



## Albert N. Badal

November 9, 1929 - January 19, 2014

Long time Modesto resident, Albert Neewya Badal, passed away Sunday, January 19, at the age of 84.

He was born November 9, 1929 to William Neewya and Eva Michael Badal in Flint, Michigan. The family moved to Chicago, Illinois, and then California, where Albert graduated from Modesto Junior College with an Associates of Arts Degree.
