



## Antonia "Toñita" Gutierrez

July 28, 1934 - May 26, 2026

Antonia "Toñita" Gutierrez, conocida cariñosamente como "Welita" por sus nietos, falleció en paz en su hogar en Turlock, California, el 26 de mayo de 2026, rodeada del amor de su familia. Nació el 28 de julio de 1934 en Rodríguez, Nuevo León, México.

Antonia fue una mujer centrada en el amor, la fe, la compasión y la familia. Tenía un espíritu cálido y generoso que hacía sentir bienvenidos y apreciados a todos los que la rodeaban. Ya fuera a través de una comida casera, palabras amables o simplemente con su presencia, dedicó su vida a cuidar y apoyar a quienes amaba.

Fue una esposa devota de su amado esposo fallecido, Guadalupe Gutierrez. La pareja se casó el 7 de junio de 1950 en Matamoros, Tamaulipas, México, y compartieron muchos años llenos de amor, construidos sobre la fe, el trabajo arduo y la dedicación a la familia. En 1966, se mudaron a California desde Texas y formaron una hermosa vida para su familia en las comunidades de Planada y Merced. La actitud perseverante y el espíritu emprendedor de Toñita los llevaron a uno de sus mayores orgullos: la compra de un ranchito de 7 acres de higos Kadota en Planada, donde la familia creció y creó muchos recuerdos inolvidables.

Antonia trabajó incansablemente en los campos de California y en la canería

por más de 35 años. Se jubiló en 1996. A pesar de las exigencias de su trabajo, su mayor alegría siempre fue su familia. Atesoró cada momento compartido con sus hijos, incluyendo a sus 18 nietos, 23 bisnietos y 7 tataranietos.

Fue devota de la Iglesia del Sagrado Corazón en Planada por muchos años. Antonia fue integrante de la Sociedad Guadalupana y de la Sociedad de Oro. Su fe la guió a lo largo de toda su vida y se reflejó en su dedicación a su comunidad parroquial. Generosamente ofrecía su tiempo cocinando para eventos de la iglesia, cantando en el coro y ayudando en actividades para recaudar fondos. Sirvió a los demás con humildad, bondad y un corazón alegre.

Antonia también disfrutaba de la jardinería, jugar lotería y bailar sus “Chotises” favoritos en reuniones familiares. Disfrutaba especialmente hacer tortillas de harina para su familia y recibir a sus nietos en su hogar para la tradición anual de preparar tamales, una tradición que continuará viviendo a través de las recetas y recuerdos que ella creó. Su hogar era un lugar lleno de calidez, risas y amor incondicional.

Le sobreviven sus hijos: Juanita Gutierrez, Rodolfo Gutierrez (Carmen), Guadalupe Gutierrez Jr. (Edith), Jose Gustavo Gutierrez (Socorro), Rogelio Gutierrez (Tere) y Carolina Gutierrez Alfaro (Jose de Jesus). A devoted parishioner of Sacred Heart Church in Planada, Antonia was an active member of the Guadalupana Society and Sociedad de Oro. Her faith guided her throughout her life and was reflected in her dedication to her church community. She generously volunteered her time cooking for church functions, singing in the choir, and helping with fundraising activities. She served others with humility, kindness, and a joyful heart.

Antonia also enjoyed gardening, playing Loteria and dancing to her favorite “Chotis” at family gatherings. She especially enjoyed making homemade tortillas for her family and hosting the grandchildren at her home for an annual tamal making tradition that will continue to live on through the recipes and memories she created. Her home was a place filled with warmth, laughter, and unconditional love.

She is survived by her children, Juanita Gutierrez, Rodolfo Gutierrez (Carmen), Guadalupe Gutierrez Jr.(Edith), Jose Gustavo Gutierrez (Socorro), Rogelio Gutierrez (Tere), and Carolina Gutierrez Alfaro (Jose de Jesus). She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Guadalupe Gutierrez, and her grandchildren, Monica Martinez, Diego Alfaro, and Adrian Alfaro.

A visitation will be held on Monday, June 1, 2026, from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., with a rosary at 6:00 p.m. at Turlock Funeral Home.

A funeral Mass will be held on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. at Sacred Heart Church in Planada, California. Following the Mass, Antonia will be laid to rest at Plainsburg Cemetery in Merced, California.
