



## Carlos Marchbanks

We are sad to announce the passing of Carlos Eugene Marchbanks, aged 90. Carlos passed away peacefully on April 7, 2023. Carlos was surrounded by his loving family at the time he was called to be with the Lord.

Carlos was married for 67 years to his wife, Evelyn, who he met in 1954 at a dance. He enlisted in the Navy and was part of the Weapons Dept. from August 1951 to August 1955. After his service with the Navy, he proceeded to serve as a Mechanical Engineer for the Naval Air Reserve from August 1955 to April 1964. Once again, Carlos was not done serving his country. He enlisted in the National Guard Army as a drill sergeant from April 1964 to April 1968, and he was a member of the California State Rifleman's Team as a Marksman. Carlos' passion to serve was then focused on his community. He was in the Turlock Volunteer Fire Dept., a Hunter Safety Course Instructor, Cub Scout Leader, Commander for the American Legion as well as a Lifetime Member, and Sons in Retirement (SIR). Carlos drove trucks for a variety of companies that would inspire him to own his own truck. So with the help and support of his wife, Carlos bought a truck and fulfilled his dream as an owner operator traveling the numerous highways throughout the United States and Canada. His family was able to enjoy many spontaneous hunting, fishing, and camping trips due to his love for the outdoors and adventures.

Carlos was a generous and loving husband, father, and grandfather. He

leaves behind his wife, Evelyn Marchbanks; his sons, Charles Marchbanks and Wayne Marchbanks II; his daughter, Charlotte Parga (Dan); his two grandchildren, Derek Alvernaz (Heather) and Cody Marchbanks (Amanda). He was preceded in death by his father, Wayne Marchbanks; his mother, Hazelle Duncan; and his siblings.
