Chelsea Atherton, 26, was born in Modesto. She died Sunday in Fresno. She was a graduate of Sacred Heart School, Denair High School, and CSUS. In 2009, she entered Alliant College in Fresno to attain her Doctor of Psychology degree to become a Clinical Psychologist.

Chelsea was blessed with a caring heart, an infectious laugh, and genuine concern for others. She had a passion for animals, the great outdoors, and was happiest when she was with family and friends. She grew up with God, and her faith in Him never waivered.

A visitation will begin at 2 p.m. on Sunday, October 31 at Turlock Funeral Home, with a recitation of the rosary following at 6 p.m. (Halloween was one of Chelseas favorite days of the year.)

A mass of Christian burial will be held at 10:30 on Monday, November 1 at Sacred Heart Church.

A reception will follow at Turlock Memorial Park.

Interment services will be held in the DeFerrari Family plot at Divide Cemetery in Groveland on Tuesday, November 2 at 10:30a.m.
