Diane Marie Silva entered into heavenly rest at the age of 41 on Monday, January 29th, 2024 after a courageous six-year battle with breast cancer.

She attended Bohn Elementary, Williams Middle School, and Tracy High School class of 2000. After graduating high school in 2000, she attended Stanislaus State and graduated with a B.A. in Liberal Studies. Diane worked as an educator for 18 years. Over the span of her teaching career, she taught 2nd Grade at Traina Elementary. In Fall of 2021 she transitioned to teach TK at Traina Elementary, with daughter Isabela in her first TK class, and in Fall 2023 at Hawkins TK Campus. She had a passion for teaching, and enjoyed creating and crafting new projects for her students and even designed the Husky Pup logo for the new Hawkins TK Campus. She formed a strong bond and friendship with many of her colleagues and enjoyed spending time with them inside and outside of the classroom.
