Edward Kiyoshi Nakade was born June 22, 1950 in Stockton, CA, the son of the late Joseph and Marie (Higashiyama) Nakade. Ed then attended Delta College and graduated from California State University, Chico in 1972 with his Bachelor's Degree. He earned his teaching credential in 1973. Ed was employed with the Atwater Elementary School District as a teacher for over 30 years. Ed taught at Shaffer School and Mitchell K-6 before moving on to Mitchell Senior Elementary where he taught 7th grade history. While at Mitchell Senior, Ed was the student body advisor, and coached softball and basketball. He retired in 2007. Among his special interests, Ed enjoyed golfing, gardening and was an avid poker player. He was a member of the Stockton and Cortez Buddhist Churches and the Cortez JAACL. He was preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Dennis Nakade. Ed is survived by his wife Debbie of Atwater, CA; his siblings, David Nakade of Stockton, CA and Shirley Bertoni of Rockville, Maryland.
