She took pleasure in renovating her home and turning her yard into a beautiful garden. During this time, she met her future husband, whom she married in Sept. 2004. Emily spent her time enjoying an active life with her husband, family and friends. She especially enjoyed traveling, gardening and baking. Her creative and artistic talents were endless and she continued to do freelance graphic design work for many years. Emily was preceded in death by her father, Charles, in 2007. She leaves behind her husband of 6 1/2 years, Joshua Cullum; their beloved dog, Pete; her mother Pam Genzoli; her sister Melissa (David) Ramont; her grandparents, Everett and Mary Anne Aldrich; loving aunts, uncles and cousins and her father and
