Irma Garcia Maldonado went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, September 21, 2019 in Turlock, CA. She was 55 years old. Born in Mexico to Silvester and Raquel Gonzalez Garcia, she was raised in the Ceres and Livingston communities. She graduated from Livingston High School and attended Modesto Junior College, where she earned an AS Degree.

Irma worked as a Secretary for Schendel Elementary School and as a Representative Assistant for Teamsters Union before finding her calling as a Family Services Specialist for the past 20 years.

In her spare time, Irma loved gardening and drawing. She adored taking trips to the beach, camping and wine tasting with her family and friends. A woman of faith, she was an avid member of Sacred Heart Church.

Irma was preceded in death by her father, Silvester Garcia; brother, Joe Garcia; and her nephew, Joey Garcia. She leaves behind her loving husband, Ignacio Maldonado and their two sons, Allen and Aaron Maldonado.

A viewing will be held from 4 to 6 p.m., followed by the Rosary at 6 p.m., on Wednesday, September 25, 2019 at Turlock Funeral Home, 425 N. Soderquist Rd., Turlock. 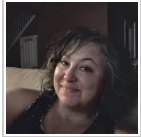
