October 24, 1919 - April 5, 2015

Jack Powell, 95, of Modesto passed away on April 5, 2015 in a Modesto hospital. Jack was born October 24, 1919 in Keota, Oklahoma. He was raised in that area and graduated from high school in McCurtin, Oklahoma. In 1941, he joined the United States Coast Guard and served five years. Jack married Lois Morton in Baltimore, Maryland during the war and they came to California in 1956 settling in Millbrae. Mr. Powell was employed by the federal government at the Department of Housing and Urban Development and retired from there following 30 plus years of service. After retirement they came to Modesto to live. Jack was an avid golfer and was formerly a member of the Chester Men's Golf Club.

He is survived by his daughter Barbara Panigiris (George), grandchildren, Nick Panigiris, Michelle Panigiris, and great-grandchildren, Krista and Zander Panigiris. He was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Lois Powell, in 2007.
