



## Jacqueline Johnson Parker

November 11, 1936 - March 10, 2016

Jacqueline Johnson Parker of Turlock died on Thursday, March 10, 2016. She was born in Pendleton, Oregon on November 8, 1936 to Vivian and Sidney Johnson and was descended from sheep ranching Swedish ancestors of the 1800's. She was also descended from farming Genovese Italian pioneers in the Lockeford and Lodi area. Jackie graduated from Lodi High School and UC Berkeley, married Thomas Hilary Parker and settled in Davis and Berkeley in the 50's and 60's. Later she returned to graduate school, earning degrees in nursing, psychology and counseling and moved to Turlock in the early 80's. She worked in hospitals and schools in the Bay Area and Central Valley, most recently as a Marriage and Family Counselor. Jackie did not retire until shortly before her death. While working part time she traveled throughout the US, Europe and parts of Asia, and enjoyed cooking, the SF Symphony and Ballet, her family and friends and her numerous grandchildren. Family gatherings and holidays were never missed and she always assisted those in need in the community. Survivors are husband Thomas of Turlock, son Eric (Carla) of Piedmont, daughter Marie (Matthew) Watson of Morgan Hill, son Stuart (Christine) of San Ramon, son Jeffery of Benicia and son Carl (Shannon) of Turlock. Also surviving are her sister Joelle Triebisch, ten grandchildren, one great grandson, many nieces, nephews and cousins and her beloved Australian Shepherd Jake.
