Dr. James Abbott Ferrell Jr., born on February 5, 1983, in Harbor City, California, passed away on March 29, 2026, in Farmington, California. He was a beloved son, brother, and skilled chiropractor who dedicated his career to improving the wellness of others.

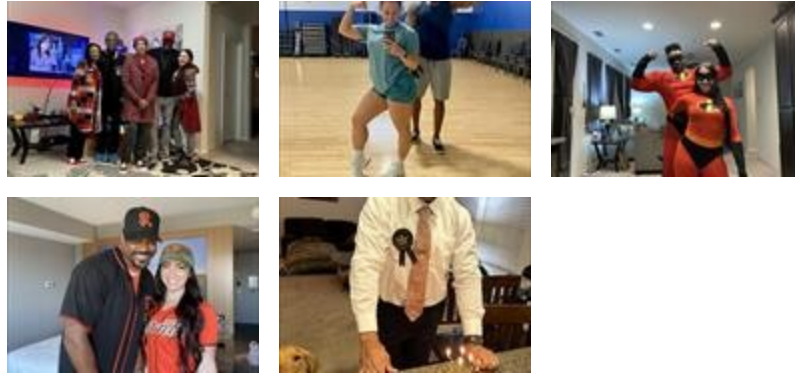
