



Joao Sylvestre De Medeiros

June 2, 1927 - December 19, 2024

Our beloved “Pai” Joao Sylvestre De Medeiros, was ushered into the loving arms of our Lord Jesus Christ, surrounded by his beloved sons, John and Mario Medeiros on December 19, 2024 at the rich age of 97 1/2 years old.

Born and raised on São Miguel Island in the Azores, Joao Sylvestre De Medeiros emerged from a humble background of subsistence farming. Growing up on his family's dairy farm, he experienced a traditional rural life characterized by manual labor and deep agricultural roots. Without modern technology, his family relied on animals for crop cultivation and milked cows by hand, embodying the resilient spirit of Azorean farmers. Joao was also in the Portuguese army and was the fastest runner in his squad.

A lifelong soccer enthusiast, Joao was deeply passionate about the sport. He religiously followed Portuguese teams like Benfica, FC Porto, and Sporting CP, watching and listening to matches daily. His love for soccer extended beyond national boundaries, embracing Brazilian and international soccer with equal enthusiasm.

Joao dedicated much of his working life to Fawcett Farms for 35 years, working diligently from 1962 until his retirement in 1997. After years in Los Banos, he settled in Atwater, becoming an integral part of the local community. After retiring, he continued working taking care of his quadriplegic son until the

age of 80.

A true family patriarch, Joao is survived by:
