September 22, 1915 - February 11, 2014

John Reehl , 98, passed away peacefully Tuesday, February 11, in Modesto. He was born Johannes Reehl on September 22, 1915 to George and Mary (Dick) Reehl, in the township of Omro, Wisconsin. John grew up in Wisconsin working on the farm with his father, where he met his future wife, Dyphna Warnke, and worked in the shipping yard during WWII. After the war he moved to Los Alamos, New Mexico, and then California, and worked for the Lawrence Livermore Lab. John and Dyphna moved to Modesto in 1970. John was an avid member of the Masons for over fifty years and graduated to master mason May 22, 1948.
