Jose Alvarez, 85, died peacefully in his sleep, in his home in Delhi, CA on Monday, January 30, 2017.

Mr. Alvarez was born on June 3, 1931 in Aguililla, Michoacan.

He was a member of the military in Mexico before immigrating to the United States in 1964. He was a parishioner of the St. Jude Thaddeus Catholic Church in Livingston, California. Being new to the country, Mr. Alvarez was employed in various capacities in Michigan. He eventually moved to California and raised his family in Merced County. He retired after 28 years of railroad service from Modesto and Empire Traction in 1998.
