



Juliette Y. Aboona

January 27, 1933 - March 24, 2012

Juliette Aboona passed away on Friday, March 23, 2012 at around 10:00 p.m. at Pacifica Senior Living Centre (a Memory care Facility).

Juliette was born in Habaniya, Iraq on January 27, 1933, from father Rab Tremma Yacoub Aboona and mother Maryam Sada. She left behind her husband Rouel Aboona. She also left behind two sons, the older Basil with his wife Jackie, and the younger Luay with his wife Lina and their children Andrew and Alan.

Juliette also left behind three brothers the eldest Sargon Aboona and his family, Khoshaba Aboona and his family, and Yuhanna Aboona and his wife Khalida, and two sisters, Khawa Pearce and her family in England, and Kathie Shlimon and her family in England.

Juliette studied nursing in England and worked as a nurse in Dar El Salam Hospital in Baghdad, Iraq. She finished her studies in business and worked first for the Iraq Petroleum Company in Baghdad, and then for the United Nations Development Program, also in Baghdad, where she became the head of the Administration and Finance.

In 1985, together with husband Rouel, they immigrated to the United States. They lived in Chicago until 2001 and then moved to Modesto, California. In

2005 she was diagnosed with the first stage Alzheimer's disease, a disease so cruel, which she fought until her last day.

Juliette was a very gracious, generous and humble person. She was friendly to everyone and always brightened everyone's days with her joy of life and the sound of her laughter. There was never any sadness in her life. She always helped others, poor or otherwise, morally and financially.

She was never sick and always took care of others, specially her husband and family. She never suffered from a major illness until this cruel disease from which she could not recover.

God Bless her. She is now in His good hands, free from sickness and the difficulties of life on earth.
