Larry Ferreira, aged 92, of Ceres, California, passed away on October 27, 2025. He was born on September 3, 1933, in Merced, California.

After graduating from Turlock High School, Larry honorably served as a Sergeant in the United States Army during the Korean War. Following his military service, Larry had a successful career as a backhoe operator, eventually owning and operating Ferreira Backhoe for 30 years.
