It was pretty cool. There were so so so many wonderful memories that I cherish of my aunty Lilly and when I had my own children, the candy tradition continued. My kids refer to her as aunty Candy. I really believe they thought that was her real name. My parents had a concrete backyard so every time my son was at my mom's she'd take him to her backyard and let him get dirty and dig for worms. I loved it and so did he! She impacted all of our lives with love acceptance, and threw it all. She did it with Grace. I love you aunty Lilly aka aunty Candy and will miss you terribly, but I take solace in knowing you are at peace and reunited with Papa Sam, Khanoum, aunty Alice, aunty Marion, and my mom.
