



## Lloyd Martin Gustafson

Lloyd “Bud” Gustafson passed away on Sunday, October 25, 2016 at the age of 85 in Turlock, CA.

Bud was born on July 16, 1931 in Denair, CA to Albert and Luella Gustafson. He was raised on the family farm in Denair. He was a graduate of Denair High School with the class of 1949.
