Michael "Mike" Pimentel, 69, of Riverbank, was born to Alfred and Eldores (George) Pimentel in Turlock. He passed away Friday in Modesto.

Mike was a graduate of Sacred Heart School in 1962, Turlock High School in 1966, MJC in 1968, and in 1970 he received his B.A. Degree in Business Administration from CSU Stanislaus. He went to work for Nattinger Lowry & Co. as a student accountant in 1969 where he remained after attaining his CPA license in 1972. Later he became a partner. From 1970 to 1976 he was a member of the CA Army National Guard.

Mike opened his own practice at Coffee and Rumble in 1982, and in 1983 he graduated with Honors from Golden Gate University in MBA Taxation.

Among the organizations in which Mike was a board member and held leadership positions include: San Joaquin Chapter of CA Society of CPA's (Pres.); CA Society of CPA's (VP); National Society of CPA's (Delegate); American Cancer Society (Pres.); Memorial Hospital Foundation (Pres.), and Modesto Lions 500 Club (Pres.).

He was a past board member of the Central Catholic High School Foundation, MJC Foundation, CSUS Alumni, and CSUS Business Advisory Board. Memberships also include the Knights of Columbus (4th Degree), Del Rio Country Club, American Legion, Elks Lodge, as well as his past membership in the SOS Club. He attended Our Lady of Fatima Church in Modesto and Sacred Heart Church in Turlock.

After his marriage to Marya Anne Pires on Feb. 20, 1971, Mike and Marya moved to Modesto and started a family. His immediate and extended families were the love of his life!

He enjoyed any sport or interest in which his children, grandchildren, and family participated, and he was a fan of the SF Giants, 49ers, and Golden State Warriors. Golfing was a favorite pastime as well.

Mike was preceded in death by his sister Sharolyn Crivelli and nephew Brian Crivelli. Besides his wife, Mr. Pimentel is survived by daughter Michelle A. Pimentel-Montez (Scott), son Michael A. Pimentel, Jr. (Whitney), and grandchildren Olivia J. Pimentel, Jack M. Pimentel, and Martin W. Montez. Survivors also include sister Joyce M. Pimentel, brother Paul A. Pimentel (Trudy), numerous nephews, nieces, cousins and family members, and MANY GREAT FRIENDS!
