



Reverend Melvin Fielding Crandall

August 29, 1922 - July 6, 2016

Reverend Melvin Fielding Crandall entered into the Kingdom of God, July 6, 2016 at the age of 93. Melvin was born in Oswego, Kansas to Morton and Ella Crandall. He was raised in Missouri until the family moved to Tipton, California. He worked on the dairy farm with his family until World War II. Melvin served his country in the U.S. Army, 3rd Division in the European Theatre of Operations. Metals awarded: Purple Heart, Good Conduct, Victory and European African Middle Eastern Campaign. After the war he married his beloved wife Lillie. Melvin became an ordained Minister with the Assemblies of God for 65 years, pastoring six churches including evangelistic work. He enjoyed fishing, camping and spending time with his family.

Melvin is preceded in death by his wife Lillie of 67 years; grandson, John Lee; daughter, Janet Crandall and son Dwight Crandall. He is survived by his brother, Calvin Crandall; sisters, Audrey Lafferty and Betty Lockford; daughters, Beverly (Joe) McGuire and Carolyn (Daniel) Guerrero; daughter in-law Lee Crandall, sons, Leland (Pam) Crandall; David (Vicki) Crandall and Reverend Tim (Maria) Crandall;

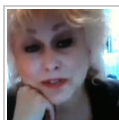
