



Rishi Ram Sharma

December 18, 1953 - June 25, 2024

Pandit Rishi Ram Sharma, aged 70, passed away on June 25, 2024, in Modesto, California. Born on December 18, 1953, in the Fiji Islands, he spent his formative years in Tavua, deeply rooted in family and community values. He married his beloved wife, Sneh Ram, on December 30, 1978, and together they nurtured a family that held tightly to these shared convictions.

Pandit Rishi was an accomplished geologist and began his career at the Vatukoula Gold Mine, from which he retired in 1995. His professional journey was paralleled by his spiritual service; he was a Hindu priest from 1980 until his passing in 2024. His dedication to faith was evident as he presided over the Nav Kiran Ramayan Faag Mandali, the Modesto Bhajan Mandali, and served as the President of the Brahman Sabha of USA.

He held a master's degree in geoscience, which underscored his analytical approach to both his professional and religious life. Pandit Rishi was a man of many interests including martial arts, gardening, and cultural singing. His life was a testament to the power of spirituality and community service, often found teaching and guiding others, officiating Hindu prayers and rituals, and organizing community outreach events.

Survived by his wife, Sneh Ram; daughters, Amrita Sundar and Akashni Jyoti Sharma; sons-in-law, David Shalen Sundar and Sumeet Sant Kumar; daughter-in-law, Pooja Prasad; and grandchildren, Amisha, Dhimisha, Ashril, Adarsh, and Tanya. He was preceded in death by his son, Pt. Amitesh Ram Sharma.

His funeral service will be held on Wednesday, July 3, 2024, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Turlock Funeral Home. Pandit Rishi Ram Sharma's life was a beacon of dedication and service, leaving behind a legacy of faith and family that will forever be cherished by those who knew him.

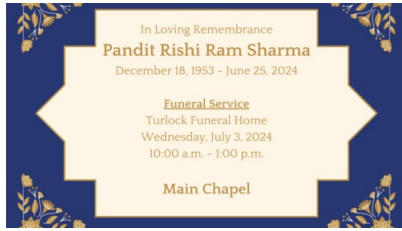
