Roger Lee Gregg, a lifelong resident of Turlock, California, passed away peacefully on December 25, 2024, at the age of 88. Born on September 19, 1936, in Iowa, Roger moved to Turlock as a child and called it home for the rest of his life.

A proud graduate of Turlock High School, Roger went on to attend the University of California, Berkeley. He dedicated his professional life to civil engineering, working in private practice for over 50 years until his retirement in 2020. His expertise and commitment left a lasting impact on the projects he undertook and the community he served.

Roger's love for sports was a defining part of his life. A talented athlete, he played professional baseball for the Kansas City Athletics and was inducted into the Turlock High School Hall of Fame. Beyond his athletic achievements, he was an avid fan of baseball and basketball throughout his life. Roger also had a deep passion for big-game hunting, a pursuit he enjoyed for more than five decades. He was a proud member of Safari Club International, reflecting his adventurous spirit and love for the outdoors.

Roger was preceded in death by his parents, Clyde Gregg and Maxine Oppett. He is survived by his beloved wife, Sheila; his children, Michael (Kathy) Gregg, Teresa Gregg, and Deanna (Brian) Dover; his stepchildren,

Jeff Cook and Brad (Stephanie) Cook; nine grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.
