She later moved to Yonkers, New York in 1970 to find better opportunities and freedom, especially as a woman. Rose worked in Yonkers as a Pastry Chef for over 25 years. Then, in 1995 she and her husband moved to Turlock to retire. She was a member of the Assyrian Church of the East, Mar Addai Parish.
