Theodore "Ted" B. Hardie, a lifelong resident of Modesto, California, passed away on February 10, 2025, at the age of 85.

Born on October 18, 1939, in Modesto, Ted attended Lincoln Elementary, Roosevelt Middle School and Downey High before furthering his education through night classes at Merced College. On July 15, 1961, he married Janet Lucas in Carson City, Nevada, beginning a devoted partnership that spanned more than six decades.

Ted dedicated 36 years of service to the state of California and served as equipment manager for fourteen years for California District 10 Caltrans before retiring in 2000. His passion for automobiles extended beyond his career—he enjoyed working on cars, building street rods, and was a member of the Pacific Pacers Car Club for several years. He also found joy in fishing, spending time with friends and family.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Theodore C. Hardie and Ora Olga Hardie, as well as his sister, Carol Collins.
