William Haringa, known to all of us as "Bill" passed away on Tuesday, May 28 in Turlock, California. He was 79 years old. He was born in Friesland, The Netherlands, the second oldest of 5 sons. He immigrated with his family to the United States after World War II seeking a better life and opportunity. They sailed aboard the Holland America "Veendam" from Rotterdam to New York City arriving January 29, 1948, eventually making their way to Inglewood, California. The family found work milking cows. Bill attended Bellflower Christian School and Excelsior High School. He served in the United States Army. He was a member of Cornerstone Community Church. He has been a successful dairyman since 1952, owning and operating dairies in Bellflower, Artesia, Chino, Ontario, Denair and Merced, California and Mountain Home, Idaho. He was always a hard worker and instilled that into his children.
