Youbert immediately became the most important member of the partnership team that existed between the US Army Field Artillery and the Kuwait Land Forces Artillery. His intelligence, knowledge of written and spoken English and Arabic, and his unmatched good judgement and wisdom were crucial in building the strong artillery partnership that exists today and helps maintain peace and stability in the Arabian Gulf region.

*Youbert was trusted by everyone that worked with him. He could bridge the social and cultural gaps, increase shared understanding and inspire confidence better than anyone I've ever known. His genuine good heart combined with a keen mind were unmatched. The lasting friendships he made amongst both the US and Kuwaiti field artillery community speak for themselves. And although he was a serious professional he had a great sense of humor and his laugh is unforgettable. We had many good times as we worked long hours to accomplish our mission.*

*One memory of Youbert stands out among the rest. In the winter of 2019 we were in the Kuwaiti desert on an artillery exercise. Youbert and I and another officer were walking at night under a full moon sky across the sand between two camps. The camels walking in the distance were casting long shadows. I had heard Youbert speak classical Aramaic in the past and so I asked him to again recite the Lord's Prayer for us. He stopped walking and did so with deepest reverence. We heard the words of Christ spoken in the language of the Savior, by a truly faithful man.*

*Youbert Kamber will leave a mark on everyone that ever knew him, and he leaves a space in our hearts that will never be filled. Greatness comes in many forms, and in Youbert's case it came in the form of a man small in stature but huge in intelligence, wisdom and grace; his humility and dedication to the mission and to his friends were examples for us to live by. I will never forget my friend.*
